Data Protection

We comply with these provisions. Personal data is treated strictly confidentially and is neither sold nor passed on to third parties.

Processing of Personal Data

Personal data refers to any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual. This includes details such as a name, email address, or phone number. Data related to leisure activities, memberships, or visited websites are also considered personal data.

Personal data is only collected, used, and transmitted by the provider if permitted by law or if users consent to the collection of data.

Access Data
